#### Who is it for?

MultiLit Literacy Centre programs have been specifically designed for school students whose literacy skills are at a level considerably lower than their peers and are at risk of being left behind. If your child is struggling with reading, we can help.

#### Literacy support that works

We track the progress of all our students to ensure they meet their literacy goals, and to tailor programs to suit individual needs. Analysis has shown a substantial improvement in literacy skills on our programs over two terms, with students making gains (on average) of:

- 13 months in word reading
- 13 months in spelling
- 18 months in decoding
- 13 months in passage reading accuracy
- 11 months in passage reading comprehension

### **Programs available**

MultiLit Literacy Centres offer a range of individualised programs including:

- Early Literacy Skills Program for children in the early years of school
- MiniLit Sage for Year 1 and Year 2 students
- Reading Tutor Program for Year 2 through to adults

- Comprehension for Year 1 upwards
- Writing for all ages
